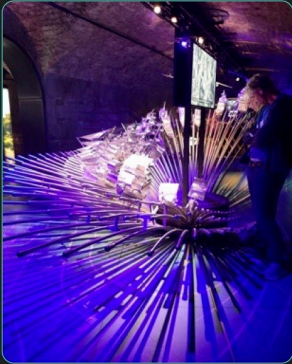
10.10.2023

The Book of Kells is written in Latin. The letters J, U and W were not used by the scribes; they were added in the middle ages. U and W developed from V, and J was created from the letter I. Q was used only before a U that was followed by a vowel.
